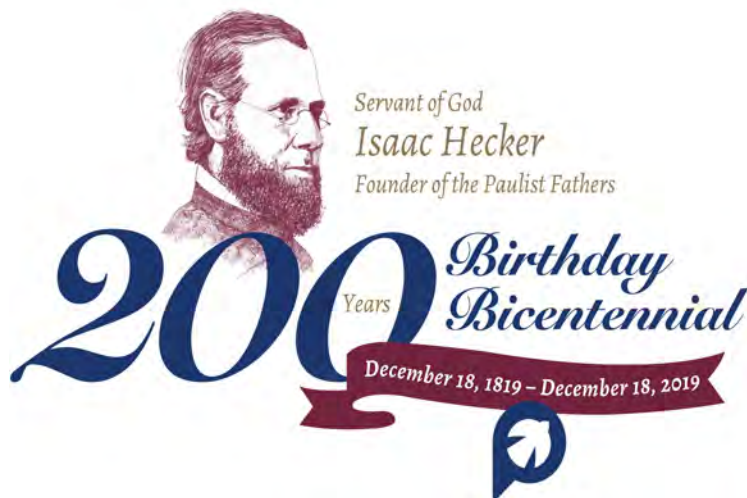

From the Pastor:

Today, the Church celebrates the **Baptism of the Lord**, the second of the three Epiphany “mysteries.” Jesus’ Baptism marks the formal beginning of Jesus’ public life and ministry and so in a sense signifies the culmination of what the Christmas season has been about.

Next week, we will welcome Paulist Father Matthew Berrios, who will speak at all the Masses to inaugurate our **Annual Paulist Appeal**.

Born in 1988, Father Matt is a native of Grand Rapids, MI, where he earned his bachelor's degree in music and philosophy from Grand Valley State University in 2011. He first met the Paulist Fathers at the Catholic Information Center in Grand Rapids. He entered the Paulist Fathers’ novitiate in the fall of 2011. He completed a Master of Divinity degree as well as a Bachelor of Sacred Theology (STB) from The Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C., and was ordained a priest by Bishop Gerald Kicanas of Tucson, AZ, at the Paulist “mother church,” the Church of St. Paul the Apostle in New York City, on May 20, 2017. He presently serves as associate pastor at the Church of St. Paul the Apostle in New York.

Since 1973, The Paulist Fathers have had the joy and privilege of serving at Immaculate Conception, the oldest Catholic parish in Knoxville. Today, Fr. Tim Sullivan and I continue that longstanding tradition of service and pastoral care to our parish and the downtown Knoxville community. The Paulists are a missionary community that forms Catholics for mission, and we are blessed to be able to share the Good News of Christ and his Church with you here in East Tennessee week after week.

In this bicentennial year, when we commemorate the 200th anniversary of our Paulist founder Servant of God Isaac Hecker’s birth, I especially invite you to participate in this Annual Paulist Appeal. Your help will provide much needed support for Paulist Ministries, for vocation outreach, and for the formation of future Paulist priests (such as Fr. Michael Hennessy, who served at Immaculate Conception as a seminarian and who is now a Paulist priest at the Cathedral of Saint Andrew in Grand Rapids, MI). Jesus' identity as the Beloved Son of the Father governed his behaviors, attitudes, and expectations. Recall that at our Baptism we were made children of this same heavenly Father. How does this identity as a member of the family of God govern and shape your family life?
