From the Pastor:

Happy Mother's Day! The Paulist Fathers and the Immaculate Conception Parish Staff wish all the mothers of our parish a very happy and blessed Mother's Day!

Today is the **56th Annual World Day of Prayer for Vocations**. The theme this year is ***The courage to take a risk for God's promise***. In his *World Day of Prayer for Vocations* Message, Pope Francis has written: *it is not always easy to discern our vocation and to steer our life in the right direction. For this reason, there needs to be a renewed commitment on the part of the whole Church – priests, religious, pastoral workers and educators – to provide young people in particular with opportunities for listening and discernment. There is a need for a youth ministry and a vocational promotion that can open the way to discovering God's plan, above all through prayer, meditation on God's word, eucharistic adoration and spiritual accompaniment.... On this World Day of Prayer for Vocations, let us join in prayer and ask the Lord to help us discover his plan of love for our lives, and to grant us the courage to walk in the path that, from the beginning, he has chosen for each of us.*

Speaking of vocations, I will be in New York later this week to celebrate several important Paulist moments. On Thursday, May 16, Paulist Fathers Don Andrie and Jerry Tully will celebrate their 25th anniversary of ordination with a Mass at the Paulist "Mother Church" in New York, the same church where they were ordained on May 14, 1994. On Friday morning, I will participate in a Hecker Bicentennial Pilgrimage to Saint Patrick's Old Cathedral Basilica, where on August 1, 1844, Isaac Hecker was received into the Catholic Church by Bishop John McCloskey. We will tour the Basilica, the cemetery, and the crypt (where one of the Paulist founders, Father Francis Baker is buried and where Isaac Hecker himself was briefly interred until the crypt at the Paulist church was completed). Then, during lunch in the cathedral rectory, I will give a presentation to the group on the continuing significance of Hecker's early life and vocational discernment. On Saturday, Paulist Deacon Evan Cummings will be ordained a priest by Timothy Cardinal Dolan, Archbishop of New York. Evan is a native of Clearfield, Utah, and grew up at St. Rose of Lima Parish in Layton, UT, a parish founded by the Paulist Fathers in 1948 and staffed by the Paulists until 1989. After earning a bachelor's degree in philosophy from Utah State University, he entered our novitiate on August 24, 2013, made his first promises to the Paulist community on July 26, 2014, studied Theology at the Catholic University of America in Washington, DC., made his final promises to the Paulist community on August 31, 2018, and was ordained a transitional deacon during a Mass in the Crypt Church of the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C. on September 1, 2018. Finally, next Sunday morning, Fr. Cummings will celebrate his First Mass at Saint Paul the Apostle Church. After all that, I will fly to California for a few days to celebrate my mother's 97th birthday.
